THE DESIGN OF SOCIALIZATION MATERIAL BASED ON PERMENDIKNAS NO 17, 2010 FOR EARLY PREVENTION ON THE THESIS PLAGIATORS OF STUDENTS IN UMSU (MUHAMMADIYAH UNIVERSITY OF NORTH SUMATRA), INDONESIA

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ABSTRACT: Honesty, integrity and authenticity are the main elements that need to be implanted in students in academic excitement. Behavior that upholds the value of science must be a barometer for students in every scientific activity either in making the task of college or completing the final task in the form of thesis writing. The thesis must have a quality value in terms of authenticity, objectivity, and honesty. If any of the words, sentences, paragraphs, ideas, or opinions in the text are the property of others, the scientific ethic is: to include the source in an honest and objective manner where he obtains the quotation. But the problems that arise in the academic world of the campus are so light that the college students in plagiarizing, copying and acknowledge the work of others for their own interests. This fact is more aggravated the absence of seriousness campus in the early prevention, and strict sanctions for the plagiarists. The problems in the Muhammaidyah Higher Education of North Sumatra, the students are only equipped with guidebooks making the thesis, but not accompanied by the academic rules that must be obeyed, if there is any plagiarism by students. The researcher believes if the commitment is mutually agreed, then the entire academic community must be submissive and obedient in realizing it, because it has a legal hold that makes all the parties afraid to violate it. This is the specific target of this study so that it makes the sanctions that cause the deterrent effect to the plagiarists. By observing, it is important in determining a legal sanction for plagiarists in campus and it is necessary to formulate a policy texts for Muhammadiyah Higher Education by departing from various legal parameters, namely the model of plagiarism socialization, rule setting and legal sanction in accordance with the level of guilt, the plagiarism types and its governing rules, methods and prevention media used and the implementation of rules and sanctions. In the long period, this research will produce a permanent policy manuscript product which is expected to be able to overcome all the forms of plagiarism behavior in Higher Education.

INTRODUCTION

Campus is a place for implanting and development of qualified human, full of character and scientific atmosphere. The scholarship of the campus community will be reflected in a rational and systemic attitude and mindset. This is determined by his obedience to the scientific principles in implementing the Tri Dharma of higher education.

One of the most important components and a barometer of the success of Tri Dharma higher education is the college student, because they are "intellectual community that have sharp analytical powers in comprehending the social and nature phenomenon comprehensively (Ali, 2000: 85) as basic component in an educational institution high, students have an important role for the progress and development of the nation. Students who are candidates of

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intellectuals as well as the younger generation have a moral responsibility to the survival of their nation. It should be given a special attention to obtain educational opportunities that have more value. And from them it is expected to appear the intellectual cadres of leaders who bring the nation and people of Indonesia towards a more prosperous and well life.

Students are the most important component in an institution of higher education because all academic and non academic activities will ultimately be measured from how big the quality of process and the quality of the learner who is called a qualified and reliable graduate. A deep observation of the world of the student problems will determine the understanding of university managers to the fundamental problems of the students, especially those related to the academic tasks, namely the writing of a thesis as one of the requirements to graduate the education degree.

Following the above ideas, it is time for universities to give particular attention to the rampant problems among the college students and, as ignored, the behavior of falsification, fabrication and plagiarism. The plagiarism action closes the authenticity of a writing format from words, sentences, paragraphs, ideas and ideas used, as is commonplace. This may be due to the absence of rules and firmness of internal sanctions and binding on the college students. It cannot be tolerated, as if it were a practice of omission. It is necessary to have a firmness of scientific ethics from universities, so that the graduates produced by law faculty of UMSU can be relied upon and accounted for academically and the quality of UMSU law graduates in scientific character. Because of the success of a student in the community will not only be reliable with scholarly, there are important factors that determine and contribute significantly to their future, that is honesty (Tilaar, 1998: 372).

Honesty or scientific authenticity in writing is included in the character building frame. That is, the members of academic community should always keep the spirit of developing value and character. (Ismail 2006: 4). If this value is lost, or faded, then immediately the quality of humanity, especially in the campus environment will also disappear. In fact, the Minister of National Education, Muhammad Nuh mentioned, "the rise of plagiarism shows the weakness of character, culture, and moral education in the academic world" (Rachmad, 2010: 15). The characteristics and attitudes contained in academic-scientific ethical items that must be upheld are honest and objective in scientific life (Student and Lecturer's Ethics UNY, 2005). One activity related to the value of honesty in scientific life is the attitude in writing thesis. In the context of writing and research, the thesis directly related to the student is Final Project Thesis. One of the highest values of writing is originality or authenticity. This statement implies that a paper must have a quality value in terms of authenticity, objectivity, and honesty. The meaning of 'original' does not mean all ideas, and knowledge submitted by someone in his thesis, all derived from himself. Rather more on honesty in expressing his writings. If the words, sentences, paragraphs, ideas, ideas or opinions raised in the text are the property of others (or from other sources), then the scientific ethic is to include the source of honestly and objectively in which it gets the quotation.

The problems that can be raised in response to the above phenomenon are 1) How is the view of the students of UMSU law faculty to the thesis plagiarism among the students, 2) What legal effort has been conducted by the law faculty of UMSU for early prevention of the student's thesis plagiarism.

LITERATURE REVIEW

Plagiarism (Understanding, Characteristics, Rules and Legal Sanctions)

Based on Permendiknas No. 17 year 2010, the definition of plagiarism is:

- a. Plagiarism is a deliberate or unintentional act of obtaining or attempting to obtain a credit or value for a scientific work, citing some or all other scientific works and/or scientific work acknowledged as a scientific work, without declaring the source properly and adequately.
- b. Plagiarist is an individual or group of persons who act the plagiarism, each act is for his own, for a group or for and on behalf of an agency.
- c. Prevention of plagiarism is a preventive action undertaken by the Head of Higher Education that aims to avoid the plagiarism in the college environment.
- d. Prevention of plagiarism is a repressive action undertaken by the Higher Education Leaders through imposing sanctions on the plagiarist within the college whose purpose is to restore the academic credibility of the college (Article 1 paragraph 1 4)

Plagiarism includes but is not limited to:

- a. Referring and/or quoting terms, words and/or sentences, data and/or information from a source without mentioning the source in the citation note and/or without adequately declaring the source;
- b. Referring and/or randomly citing terms, words and/or sentences, data and/or information from a source without mentioning the source in the citation note and/or without adequately declaring the source;
- c. Using the source of ideas, opinions, views, or theories without adequately declaring the source;
- d. Formulating with words and/or sentences from sources of words and/or sentences, ideas, opinions, views, or theories without adequately declaring the source;
- e. Submitting a scientific work produced and/or has been published by the other party as his scientific work without adequately declaring the source (Article 2 paragraph 1).

RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

Research and Development Model

This research was conducted by using normative and descriptive methods. The steps of each method used are:

Normative Study

a. Stage of research and law data collection based on the literature which related to the elements of a material socialization.

- b. Collecting data and information about positive legal provisions formulated in Permendiknas RI No 17 year 2010.
- c. Theories about the development of students' scientific character in the ethics of a thesis writing.
- d. The impact of the absence of campus settings against the violations of scientific ethics.

Descriptive Study

- a. Collecting the data about the students' views and idealism on the prevalence of plagiarism among the students,
- b. Listing the number of UMSU students who will complete the final assignment at UMSU Law Faculty,
- c. Knowing what legal efforts of UMSU law faculty has made for early prevention of students' thesis plagiarism,
- d. Providing an explanation of the types of scientific violations committed by students, in the form of falsification, fabrication, and plagiarism,
- e. Determining the type of violation based on the degree of authenticity format for a writing format from the words, sentences, paragraphs, ideas and ideas used, and student expectations of a socialization pattern that should be applied to the campus for early prevention of thesis plagiarism among students.

RESULT AND DISCUSSION

The commitment of UMSU Law Faculty to the Formulation of Socialization Material Design for Prevention of Early Plagiarism of Thesis

Plagiarism is a form of theft of thought, data or findings, including unpublished ones. There are five (5) levels of plagiarism, most of which are found among students which can be extracted from various views:

- 1. Copying (without giving acknowledgment) word-word from all posts, or most of the writing, or copying word-word in more than one post by the same author,
- 2. Copying (without giving acknowledgment) a word-word partial writing or copying wordword more than one text by the same author,
- 3. Copying (without giving acknowledgment) word-word elements of the article (paragraphs, sentences, illustrations, etc.) that give an important part in a post,
- 4. Copying by improperly paraphrasing paragraphs or pages without providing acknowledgment.
- 5. Copying (by giving recognition) word-word most of the writing without giving a clear delineation (quote or indent),

- 6. Repeating the writings themselves that have been published without mentioning them as reference materials which is also one form of plagiarism which is commonly called self-plagiarism,
- 7. Taking ideas or opinions of others and expressing them in their own words.

From the questionnaires distribution to the sixth semester students of Study Programs of Criminal Law, Civil Law, Constitutional Law and State Administration Law of UMSU, which numbered 90 people, it can be summarized their views and understanding of the plagiarism concept. The indicators are made in the formulation of the basis for the model of socialization that the researcher will make a model of socialization plagiarism, and as a permanent reference of UMSU law students. The data below is the result of the commitment of the UMSU students, in the form of *agree, strongly agree, strongly disagree, disagree* and *doubt* about the design of socialization materials that will be made for the effort to minimize the students' plagiarism behavior, with the indicators: 1) the student about plagiarism behavior and its causal factors, 2) what motivation cause plagiarism rampant among the students, 3) the media and 4) the effective method conducted for socialization of plagiarism to student:

What Legal Efforts Have UMSU Law Faculty Made for Early Prevention of the Students' Thesis Plagiarism?

From analyzing the archive, the researcher obtained that there is already a guideline of thesis writing issued by UMSU Law Faculty. However, the guidebook only regulates 1) the drafting procedure, 2) the proposal format and the thesis report; 3) the requirements in taking part the seminar, 4) the guiding requirements, 5) the writing procedure, 6) the format, the systematic and the procedure of delivering scientific publications. Observing this phenomenon, it is illustrated that the faculty has believed that all the students have knowledge and commited about the plagiarism. It means that UMSU law students are considered to know about citing ideas, words, paragraphs and paraphrases. It is also about the ethics of science in reading the work of others and be inspired in writing their own works and research data that is considered legitimate to meet the corridor of authenticity as own research data or the data that directly taken by researchers to the field.

Some progress that the researcher noted, there has been a commitment and positive intention of the study program to give understanding and require the students to follow the ethics of writing for a quoted work. There are two elements that the researcher noted here, namely 1) writing a bibliography and citations, 2) procedures and guidelines for writing a bibliography and writing citations that are described in the manual.

Indications of Behavior and Motivation of UMSU Students' Plagiarism Action and Efforts to Minimize It

The factors that cause plagiarism are internal and external factors. The internal factors include anxiety, stress, fear of failure. Low self-esteem, and pessimistic attitude toward self-ability. Meanwhile the external factors that cause the occurrence of action plagiarism, among others are environmental permissive attitude to plagiarism behavior, less sensitive to the symptoms

that cause the emergence of plagiarism behavior, the unequivocal attitude of the institution against the sanctions given for plagiarism behavior, the tendency to cover the case plagiarism case due to fear of negative image on institutions, negative influences and over-demanding demands from friends, schools, parents, and society.
